

# What We Offer



The Cranbrook History Centre offers curriculum based activities for grades K to 7 (8 to 12 at request) set in the Cranbrook Museum, as well as a walking tour through our most popular set of train cars: the 1929 Trans Canada Limited.

For \$3.50/student we offer a one and a half hour visit comprised of a tour of the Trans Canada and a curriculum based scavenger hunt. The details of the tour and activities have been included in this information package. For an extra \$0.50/student, your class can bring their lunch and eat it in our dining car (max 30 students).
