Our Ed Talk is a free education program that is offered to a community of lifelong learners. Each month, a guest (or a panel of guests) is invited to share their knowledge of the natural and local and regional history. In May, that expert guest could be you!

The Heritage Fair Ed Talk consists of your presentation and several other student presentations, each about 5 to 10 minutes in length.

During the presentation, you will share what you learned about your topic, as well as provide other insights, such as:

Why did you choose the topic you did?

What surprised you during the research process?

What did you learn about yourself along the way?

Why do you think knowing history is important?

Please plan to showcase your project board as you talk about it or prepare a slideshow with or without prerecorded audio if you wish. We could format your presentation as an interview. Perhaps you could even have the audience engage in an activity or discussion and invite them to ask questions.
